✓ APPOINTMENT CHECKLIST

You must bring the following to receive free tax help:

- Valid picture identification for taxpayer and spouse.
- Social Security cards and birth dates for yourself, spouse, and dependents.
- All W-2s, W-2Gs, 1099s, and Social Security/Unemployment benefit statements related to income received during 2024
- If filing jointly, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms.
- Forms 1095-A, B, or C (Affordable Health Care Statements).

Additional information that may be required:

- If claiming child and dependent care expenses: the name, address, and social security number or EIN (employer identification number) of the provider.
- If claiming the Indiana Renter's Deduction: the name, address, and phone number of the landlord.
- If a homeowner: a copy of your county real estate tax statement.
- Any tax forms received.
- Copies of last year's federal/state tax returns.
- For direct deposit of your refund, you must provide bank account and routing numbers.
- All 1098s related to interest on student loans, including 1098-T.
- Out-of-pocket educational expenses for college.
- Any donations to Indiana colleges.

* Sites are not able to assist if, in 2024, you owned/sold rental property, sold a business, had more than \$35,000 in business expenses, had business loss, or bought/sold stocks, bonds, mutual funds, or cryptocurrency. Visit unitedwaysci.org/freefile to find the product that's right for you.
